KEVIN & SANDY BARNER



Kevin and Sandy Barner are fully appointed Assemblies of God missionaries serving in Peninsular Asia. Their journey has been marked by a deep commitment to shepherding both congregations and fellow missionaries across the globe.

Their missionary story began in 2002, when they moved to Russia to lead International Christian Assembly (ICA) in Moscow—an English-speaking congregation that welcomed people from around the world. For seven and a half years, they nurtured a vibrant international church community in the heart of Moscow.

In 2010, their calling led them to Thailand, where they pastored ICA Bangkok for nearly six years. Once again, they provided leadership and pastoral care in a diverse, multicultural setting, helping people grow in faith and mission.

From 2017 to 2019, the Barners shifted into a regional leadership role as Area Pastors for Eurasia Northwest. They supported missionaries across seven countries—Armenia, Estonia, Georgia, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, and Ukraine—offering spiritual guidance, encouragement, and pastoral care to those serving on the frontlines.

Since 2020, their focus has been on Peninsular Asia, where they serve as Area Pastors and Mentoring Advocates. With over 200 missionaries across Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, and Vietnam, Kevin and Sandy work to foster a healthy, sustainable environment—equipping missionaries to thrive as they reach people who have yet to hear the Gospel.

In addition to their regional responsibilities, they've also been asked by Asia Pacific Regional Director Jeff Hartensveld to serve as interim pastors for international churches across the 40 nations of the Asia Pacific region. This allows them to step in and provide stability when missionary pastors must step away temporarily, ensuring continuity for congregations across the region.
